2.Simile:

3. Metaphor:

He's a fiend in feline shape, a monster of depravity.

Just controls their operations: the Napoleon of Crime!

4. Repetition:

Macavity, Macavity, there's no one like Macavity

Macavity's not there!

5. Hyperbole:

He's broken every human law, he breaks the law of gravity

6. Personification:

His brow is deeply lined....
